



INTERGEM PRESENTED THE YS 18 STUNNING RED CARPET JEWELLERY COLLECTION AT THE INDIA INTERNATIONAL JEWELLERY WEEK 2011

Intergem presented the YS 18 line titled The Royal Collection" at the India International Jewellery Week 2011 in 18K white, yellow and rose coloured gold. Created in 1984 by designer and artist, Yogendra Sethi the YS 18 line of jewellery has always been known for its creative use of brilliant white, natural fancy coloured diamonds and exotic precious gemstones which has ornate floral motifs studded with rose cut diamonds, old mine cuts and diamond briolettes.

Translating the colours of nature the jewellery spoke a magnificent creative language of beauty and style. Cuffs with a tantalizing cluster of stones, giant onyx with a mélange of tiny gems, a garden of green Peridots, tourmalines and citrines; the diamond and emerald asymmetric necklace and the fragile leaf design earrings were gorgeous works of jewellery.

The ruby prongs for diamond necklace and earrings, the floral motif bracelets and rings, the collar in a prominent Basel setting and the long chains of precious stones told a Romanic story for jewellery that had that nostalgic touch.

With a regal Victorian theme for the jewellery, the nostalgia was further carried in the creations by Riyaz Gangji featuring 16 royal saris and 8 beautifully flowing gowns. Fabrics like lace, chiffon, and georgette embellished with Swarovski jewels were used to create that Victorian look. Elegant colours ranging from pastel peach, pink and





mauve to light brown gave the feeling of an earthy, rustic look with minimal embroidery. Blouses were dramatic while the gowns had a rustic feel with jewellery being the prime embellishment.

The show stopper of the evening was the beautiful Bollywood star Sonal Chauhan wearing an imposing floral corsage necklace, rings, earrings and bracelet.

The YS 18 collection presented by Intergem was a gorgeous offering to women who cherish their jewellery for a lifetime.
