Making the bridal jewellery collection more comprehensive were nose rings and Maang Tikka to match the various gem studded collars.

The glittering four rows of kundan and minakari around the neck, the Kaan Phool and the very unconventional towering ring; the turquoise, coral, ruby, emerald, diamond prong neck piece and the innovative hair ornaments gave more options to bridal jewellery. Rows of emeralds and pearls were dreamt up to create Haars and strands of kundan edged with pendants alternating with pearl streamers were stunners.

Ending the show was the very sexy Isha Koppikar wearing a magnificent kundan, ruby, emerald creation spread over shoulders and yoke and teamed with impressive giant earrings, bracelets and rings.





To balance the beauty of the jewellery the elegantly designed net saris with minimal embroidery in pastel shades by Jashn added to the glamour of the presentation.
